



#### **GRADUATION DRESS CODE**

# DRESS CODE BACCALAUREATE AND COMMENCEMENT 2012

In order to provide continuity and consistency in attire, a mandatory dress code is required for all graduating seniors for the baccalaureate ceremony and commencement exercises. If your child does not adhere to the following requirements, they WILL NOT be allowed to participate in either ceremony.

#### **Boys**

Black slacks
White shirt (no pullovers)
Black tie (no bow ties)
Black shoes (dress/church shoes)
Black socks

#### <u>Girls</u>

Black dress with sleeves (no more than 2 inches above the knee; no spaghetti straps; no tight-fitting, spandex-type, body-hugging dresses will be allowed) Hose (black, off-black, or neutral) Black shoes (pumps only [toe and heel must be enclosed]; no more than three-inch heel)

NOTE: Robes will not be worn for Baccalaureate. Robes will be worn for Commencement.

Church attire (all black ONLY) is required for Baccalaureate. Young men must wear ties for both events. Young men will be allowed to wear a white shirt and black tie with black pants for Baccalaureate. Young ladies will be allowed to wear Pant Suits for Baccalaureate

ONLY (not a blouse and pants). Kinte cloths are mandatory for Baccalaureate! (The Kinte cloths will be available for purchase through the Senior Class Sponsors.)
